Techniques include pair 3-rod arrow, 4-rod twining and start/stop weaving.

The weaving is continuous and turns out-side-in at the opening. Anne's Vertical Herringbone Braid is done in cane and adorns the outside. Ann's braid is done in a manner that leaves no loose ends on the inside of the basket.
